Aseptic Surgery Forum for prevention, diagnostic, and treatment of post-surgical infections

3 & 4 APRIL 2012 • PARIS • ESPACE CHAMPERRET

The 2nd edition of Aseptic Surgery Forum will take place on April 3rd & 4th in Paris at the Espace Champerret. Over 1,200 professionals from some thirty countries are expected to attend.

This multidisciplinary meeting for the prevention, diagnostic, and treatment of post-surgical infections aims :

- to structure and improve the management of infected patients
- to improve professional practices in terms of hygiene
- to promote and explore fundamental research on the as yet little known mechanisms involved in these infections.
- To gather the practitioners and experts in the various medical and technological fields who assist daily in the fight against infection

The programme of **Aseptic Surgery Forum 2012** will take into account the protection of the environment and sustainable development, with lectures addressing key issues:

- Innovation for prevention, diagnosis and treatment for surgical infections
- From contamination to infection: prevention or precaution principle? Risk management
- Postoperative infection mechanism
- Express diagnose on infections : situation, prospects
- Infection risk factors from the patient: tobacco, malnutrition immunity, comorbidity, bacterial carrying etc.

- Infection risk factors from the environment: Hospital Hygiene, air - water - surface quality; operating room design, sterilization, traceability, cleaning and disinfection; hand hygiene, skin preparation; gloves, patient and health worker equipment
- Biofilms and implant infection
- Surgical instruments, ancillary equipment and medical devices: innovations in materials, surface treatments and coating, cleaning, disinfection and sterilisation, packaging, traceability, etc.
- Prophylactic antibiotic and antibiotic treatment: mode of action, bacterial resistance, new molecules
- Prophylactic antibiotic in septic surgery ; protocols personalization
- The cost of prevention and infection
- Amputation in term of septic: indications, equipment and perspectives
- Infections in other surgical specialities: the present situation
- Training, Audit, Council
