Goals and Characteristics

This Fellowship is a one-year experience with combined exposure to clinical sports medicine and arthroscopy, coupled with a research component.

Fellows will be involved in the activities of the Orthopaedic and Sport Medicine Clinic, which is a university-associated multi-disciplinary clinic. Furthermore, the Fellow will gain excellent clinical experience at the QEII Health Sciences Centre, which is the tertiary care teaching hospital of Dalhousie University.

The Fellow will be responsible for participating in active research which will be tailored to the experience of each candidate. One day per week will be protected for these research activities.

It is expected that the Fellow will participate in weekly conferences, including basic science lectures, Grand Rounds, Journal Club, and Sports Medicine Rounds.

The Fellowship will be constructed to meet the needs and expectations of each individual.
